#### From Nurse Stacy's Desk

Here are some things you can do to help your child with a cough:

- Hydrate: Offer your child plenty of fluids to thin mucus and make it easier to breathe. You can try breast milk, formula, cool water, or juice. Avoid carbonated or citrus drinks.
- Use a humidifier: Run a cool-mist humidifier in your child's bedroom.
- Use saline drops: Saline nose drops can help relieve congestion.
- Try a steamy bathroom: Sit in a steamy bathroom with your child for about 20 minutes if they have a croupy cough.
- Try a warm drink: For children over 1, you can try giving them a warm drink of lemon and honey.
- Try a mentholated rub: For children over 2, you can try rubbing a thick layer of mentholated rub on their chest and neck.

You should call your doctor if your child has a cough and:

- Has trouble breathing
- Is breathing faster than usual
- Has a blue or dusky color to their lips, face, or tongue
- Has a high fever, especially if they don't have a runny or stuffy nose
- Is younger than 3 months old and has been coughing for more than a few hours


#### Puff Pastry Fundraiser


